Community-Supported Agriculture

Customers of a farm that operates a CSA get a weekly share of farm produce in return for a fee, which is paid in advance or periodically during the growing season.

See the reverse side of this directory for local CSA options.



Seeds become better adapted to the local climate with each growing season. A Seed Library is a collection of seeds gathered and donated by local gardeners. Gardeners borrow the seeds, plant them and, at the end of the year, return some of the seeds they harvest to the library. Seed libraries distribute (for free!) and accept only open-pollinated seeds, as GMO or hybrid seeds do not reproduce "true to type". Only harvest wild plants where you have explicit permission to do so. Private tribal, city, borough, state, and federal lands all have different regulations for harvesting plants. Small harvests for personal, non-commercial use are generally allowed on state and federal lands.

Harvesting Etiquette

- · Harvest with good intentions only. Ey'uh yelqadi nihdi qeynuqeynelah qighishinsht'a niyenik'qezet ha
- Ask permission to harvest and know the "rules". Hvidilget uch'en nihdi k'eldun teh ghu nch'u nal getnih k'eldun teh ghu
- Always take someone with you who knows the plants.
- Not all plants are good for everybody.
- Know the appropriate time of year to harvest.
- When foraging on public lands, pick sparingly and leave easy foraging close to the road for Elders and those with mobility challenges.

Dozens of Kenai Peninsula fishermen have Catcher-Seller permits from ADF&G to sell fresh, whole fish ("in the round") directly to the public. Relationships are key. If you want to buy local fish to stock your freezer, ask your friends and neighbors about their sources.

You'll find family-owned businesses that sell whole salmon to individual buyers under "Seafood" on the reverse side of this directory.
